Nursery

The Nursery is available each Sunday morning from 10:00 am until 12 Noon, staffed by volunteers. Our purpose is to provide a safe environment for families with infants and small children while emphasizing the love of Jesus for all.

Sunday School/Children's Worship

While their parents attend Worship service at the 10:00 a.m. upstairs, children of all ages may participate in their very own worship. The young worshipers sing songs, learn to pray, hear a gospel message and pray for their foster child, parents, friends, teachers & personal needs. After service the children are served light refreshment during coffee time.

0-3 years... Nursery

4-6 years...Primary Class

7-10 years.... Intermediate Class

11-15 years.... Senior Class

Teens have the opportunity to study God's Word and understand the Anglican faith by taking part in the service twice a month.

Curriculum

The curriculum for 2009/2010 focuses on the Bible.

Primary Class will be using the "One Room Sunday School" which offers a comprehensive overview of the Bible, covering the major stories of the Bible over three years. Each week, the children encounter a Bible story, helping them to understand the Scripture and apply it to their daily lives. The outline of Bible stories follows the church year, so children fully experience stories of Christmas, Holy Week, Easter, and Pentecost.

Intermediate Class will start the new year with the study of David with some teaching from the One Room Sunday curriculum.

Senior Class will be using the "Whole People of God" curriculum and adding Intergenerational Worship. Yes, you will be seeing the young people taking an active part in the service on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month.
